" I am able to tell you just what happened to McIntosh, and to give the names of two eye-witnesses:- L/Cpl Cuming 49th A.I.F. B Coy and Pte J.Jones 49th A.I.F. BCoy. A shell dropped right on top of a dug-out just after McIntosh had been relieved on post. It was at midnight on the 19th July at Plug Street in front of Hill 63 to the right of Ypres. The shell blew half his head off. I took an interest in him because we were brought up together at Ipswich, Queensland. He was married and lived near Brisbane" Sgt P. Connors 3265 B. Coy 49th A.I.F.

"He was an old S. African soldier. I last saw him about 19th July at Ploogstreet about 10 p.m. I was then with him on M.G. outpost duty, in a sandbag shelter. A shell made a direct hit on it and killed him instantly and wounded Billy Barker, who is in England now. I think I saw it happen. We buried him the next night close to where he fell and a cross was put up which I have seen with his name on it. I had only known him about a week or so. He was in B Coy" Pte S.O. Perry.
