Elgin, Labourer, died of wounds 6 August 1813, Copenhagen & Walcheren, father

CROCKART, Alexander

Elgin, Labourer, c. 17 November 1812, m. "Easter" Munro

CROCKET, William

Moray, Labourer, died of wounds 10 February 1814

CUMMINGS, John (Sergeant)

Fochabers, Weaver, died of wounds 11 August 1813, Copenhagen & Walcheren, brother

DAVIDSON, William

Ardclach, Labourer, died of wounds 31 July 1813, Copenhagen & Walcheren

DENOON, John

Elgin, Weaver, killed 28 October 1811, father John

GOW, George

Elgin, Carpenter, died of wounds 24 June 1813, father Alex.

KEITH, James

Elgin, Labourer, died of wounds 14 September 1813, brother

KEITH, James  
Lossiemouth, Labourer, died of wounds 14 August 1813, father

MCINTOSH, George  
Forres, Labourer, died of wounds 14 December 1813, Walcheren, mother

MCINTOSH, James  
Moray, Labourer, died of wounds 25 July 1813

MCLEOD, Donald  
Ardclach, Labourer, supposed killed 25 July 1813, father John

MCMILLAN, William  
Moray, Labourer, died of wounds 26 July 1813, Denmark, father

RIACH, George  
Moray, Labourer, died of wounds 30 March 1814

RUSSEL, John  
Roths, Labourer, died of wounds 4 September 1813

SHAW, Alexander  
Elgin, Labourer, died of wounds 14 December 1813, sister

SUTHERLAND, Peter  
Elgin, Tailor, died of wounds 24 September 1813, Walcheren

WILLIAMSON, John  
Nairn, Shoemaker, killed 25 July 1813, wife
