Images dated 1884 (Lethen Estate, Ardcloch Parish): Mr James Mann and family at Cairnglass [1. Mann, Cairnglass]; Mrs Murdoch and family at Lynemore [2. Murdoch, Lynemore]; The Free School maintained at Knockandhu with teacher and pupils [3. School, Knockandhu]; Mr John Rose at Daltra [4. Rose, Daltra]; Mr Donald McQueen at the Carpenter's Shop near Dulsie Bridge [5. McQueen, Dulsie]; James Falconer and Alexander Cattanach tying a salmon fly at Dunearn Lodge [6. 4. Rose, Daltra

Notes:

John Rose (1804-1890) – born at Achnabechan, Ardcloch son of Alexander Rose & Janet Rose, & moved to Daltra with his parents c.1820 where he lived for the next 70 years. His father died at Daltra in 1829 & his mother died there in 1873 at the ripe old age of 96.

John Rose in Daltra & Mary Munro in Cantradown m. 15 June 1860 Croy.

They had two sons born at Daltra, Alexander b. 4 June 1861 & James John b. 18 Jan 1863 (the latter died in infancy).

Mary Munro died a few days after the birth of their second son, on 20 Jan 1863 [date given on death certificate].

John Rose died at Daltra 15 July 1890. His son Alexander, age 30 and unmarried, was still at Daltra in the 1891 census, but probably left soon after as it was a

different Alexander Rose (1842-1910) who took the lease of Daltra from Whitsunday 1891.

Ardclach Churchyard [MNFHS, 2010]:

(98) Erected by Janet Rose, in memory of her beloved husband Alexr Rose, late farmer, Daltra, who died 20th Octr 1829 aged 58.

(99) Thy will be done. Sacred to the memory of John Rose, late farmer, Daltra, who died 15th July 1890, aged 86 years. Also his beloved wife Mary Munro, who died 23rd Feb. 1863, aged 46 years. And their son John James who died in infancy.
