Elgin Courier 2 December 1831

On Saturday evening last, the wife of James Mackintosh, imprisoned in our Elgin Jail, for shop-breaking, wished to get a quantity of potatoes, which were in a bag, put into him. James Reid, the turnkey, having from some cause or other suspected something was wrong, called on one of the Magistrates to examine the contents of the bag. On opening it a load was found, newly baked, in the inside of which was a new file. From the way in which the file was placed in the loaf, the conclusion is that it must have been put in before the loaf was put into the oven.

Doug Stewart, one of our Committee members who compiled the deaths and obituaries from the *Forres Gazette*, also minded to extract some of those marriages listed, which we will put in the newsletter in this and forthcoming issues.

Making Fun of Elgin

In one of the early editions of the *Forres Gazette* we find the editor making fun of Elgin, in particular the problems with the organ in the new St Giles church.

From the edition of October 3, 1837, we have:

Death Extraordinary - Died, at Elgin, on the 7th ult., after "receiving the glimpses of the moon," and remaining under the sweet influence of the inferior luminary for two years and four months - the personifications of "St Giles," the patron Saint of the Burgh of Elgin. For the first eighteen months of his late existence, the "Saint" was hale and hearty, and admiring hundreds cheered him on in the arduous duties of a public instructor. The wild and unwary genius of "Elginensis" inspired him, but that spirit was exercised, and his die was cast (away). The "Saint" fell off every day thereafter. Labouring under increased debility, he had recourse to the quack nostrums of Doctor Banker, and Judge Baker and Son but to no purpose. His vital "Organ" was deranged, and pipe after pipe shut up. Those who believe in the transmigration of souls will not be astonished to learn that the "Saint" now animates the "little body" of an "Organ Man," and altho "the Saint" has been inveterate enemy of the Police, it is hoped they will show him the same kindness he has hitherto received "and kindly give him permission to exercise his (new) avocation in the city "and kindly reward him" as heretofore.

Marriages, Ages

Two instances of marriage announcements to be found in the *Forres Gazette* from these years illustrate the range of ages of the couples being wed.

Married, at Forres, on the 22d ult., by the Rev Mr McIntosh, Rafford, Corporal **Macfarlan** of the 72d Regt, to **Jane**, eldest daughter of Mr **Robert Grant**, proprietor. The bride is in her fourteenth year!! (October 9, 1848)

Married, at Tomintoul, on Sabbath the 15th ult., in his own house, by the Rev J McLennan, **James Stewart**, late of Achnakyle, to **Betty Cameron**, residenter, Tomintoul. The happy bridegroom,

who has seen about twice forty winter suns go round, was unable to get out of bed; but the blooming bride, who is about 60 years of age, attended to the guests with her usual alacrity. (November 1, 1854)

The first seems to be making some comment on the youth of the bride; the second celebrates the age of the husband and wife. That ages were given is unusual, and these two entries are the only two entries so far found with ages for either party.

Married, Off Abroad

As well as marriage announcements from places far afield, there are some announcements of local marriages where the newly-wed couple have immediately left on a new life overseas:

Married, at Elgin, on the 24th ult., Mr **John Gray**, late of the Post Office, to Miss **Duncan**, Garmouth. The happy couple immediately left for Van Dieman's Land. (January 2, 1839)

Married, at 71, High Street, Elgin, on the 23d inst., by the Rev Francis Wylie, Mr **John Gordon**, clothier, to **Isabella**, eldest daughter of Mr **James Leslie**, merchant. The happy pair were proclaimed and married, and left the same day per mail coach on their way to New York. (March 26, 1851)

Marriages from Overseas 1837-1855

Examples can be found of notices from Australia, Canada, India and other parts of the British Empire; also from the United States, and more unexpected places such as Russia (St Petersburg) and Argentina (Buenos Ayres):

Married, at St John's Church, Launceston, Australia, by the Rev Dr Browne, on Thursday, the 7th February last, **John Clark**, Esq., to **Jane Oswald Sinclair**, eldest daughter of the late **Thomas Eddie**, Esq., of Forres. (July 3, 1839)

Married, at Grenada, on the 4th April, at the residence of the Hon Lewis Hoyes, by the Rec J C Baker, Rector of the Town and Parish of St George, **John Poyntz Marin**, Esq., to **Mary**, third daughter of the late **Angus Fraser**, Esq., Dornoch, Sutherlandshire. (July 3, 1839)

Married, at St Petersburg, on the 10th February, **Richard Eales**, Esq., Polidoi Island, St Petersburg, to **Charlotte**, third daughter of the late Mr **James Cromar**, Rector of the Grammar School, Aberdeen. (April 1, 1840)

Married, on 23rd July, at Craighluscar, neat Thornhill, Upper Canada, by the Honourable and Right Reverend the Lord Bishop of Toronto, **Charles Courbould**, of Bracon Lodge, Esq., son of the late Rev **John Courbould**, of Bracon Ash, in the county of Norfolk, to **Mary**, second daughter of **William Durie**, Esq., K H, late Assistant Inspector of the Medical Ordinance department at Woolwich. (August 5, 1840)

Married, on the 13th ult., at Frankfort, **J Meade Swift**, Esq., M D, to **Elizabeth Rannie**, daughter of **William Grant Forsyth**, Esq., late of Elgin. (May 5, 1841)

Married, at Dozhee Ghat Azinghur, on the 17th March last, by the Rev C C B Leopolt, **Colin Robertson Tulloch**, Esq., of the Bengal Civil Service, son of the late **Wm Tulloch**, Esq., of Bogton, to **Mary Anne Caroline**, eldest daughter of the late Colonel **Nation**, C B, of the Bengal Army. (July 2, 1841)

Married, at Surry Hill, Sydney, new South Wales, on the 6th January last, Mr **William Wright**, decorative painter, to **Isabell**, second daughter of Mr **James Fimister**, Bridge-end, Forres. (June 3, 1842)

Married, at Carlton Pen, on the 22nd March, **Robert Urquhart**, Esq., of Kingston, Jamaica, to **Catherine**, daughter of Mr **John McHenry**, Whiteinch, near Forres. (June 7, 1843)

Married, at Sydney, on the 20th January last, Mr **Robert Brander**, to **Jane**, youngest daughter of the late Mr **David Forbes**, Pinefield, Elgin. (June 7, 1843)

Married, on the 23d December, in the Garrison Church of Kandy, by the Rev S O Glenie, Colonial Chaplain, Mr **Charles Urquhart Stuart**, youngest son of the late Doctor **Robert Stuart** of Grantown, to **Clarissa Sophia**, third daughter of Mr **James Harding**, Grove Hill Terrace, Camberwell, London. (April 5, 1844)

Married, at Portland, New South Wales, on the 15th March, Dr **W S Sutherland**, to **Margaret**, eldest daughter of the late **Alexander Tulloh**, Esq., Warden's Buildings, Forres. (October 5, 1844)

Married, at St John's Church, Meerut, on the 12th October last, Captain **Ranald MacDonnell**, 10th Light Cavalry, H E I C S, to **Mary Matheson**, third daughter of **Alexander Johnston**, Esq., of Newmill, Elgin. (January 4, 1845)

Married, at Norfolk, Virginia, United States, on the 8th May, Mr **John Falconer**, merchant, Baltimore, (late of Elgin), to **Charlotte L Souter**, daughter of the late Mr **Souter** of Norfolk. (July 5, 1845)

Married, on the 27th May, by the Rev C B Dana, Mr **Alexander Falconer**, of the town of Petersburg, va, to Miss **Ann Spillman**, daughter of Mr **William C Spillman** of Alex, U S. (July 5, 1845)

Married, at Singapore, on the 26th of July, **Lewis Fraser**, Esq., to **Sophia**, third daughter of the late **John Cumming**, Esq., banker, Forres. (November 5, 1845)

Married, at Secundrabad, on the 9th September, **William Campbell McLean**, Esq., M D, of the Hyderabad Residency, youngest son of the late **John McLean**, Esq., of Boreray and Drimmin, to **Letitia**, eldest daughter of the late **John McPherson**, Esq., Beauly, Inverness-shire. Criminal Court

On the 13th ult; William Kemp, one of the sailors on board the Rose, Findhorn, was tried before Sheriff Cameron at Elgin, for stealing four bottles of strong ale, &c from the shop of Mr. Clark, Merchant. Panel pled guilty, and was after a suitable admonition, fined in the sum of 10s 6d Sterling, and failing payment to be imprisoned in the jail of Elgin for 10 days. The fine was instantly paid, and the panel discharged.
